Adequate work environment

Occupational health and safety

Road safety

- Parking on the hard shoulder is dangerous
- Fatigued and stressed drivers are not optimal for road safety
- Anticipation of the route allows the driver to concentrate on the road



Security and safety through secure parking

- Information on parking areas must be reliable, so that the drivers know which security level and which comfort level they can expect
- Secure parking areas provide a safe environment for drivers, which enhances the quality of their stay
- Overall more parking areas are needed, including more secure parking areas
