- electronic alarms
- tracking devices
- pre-trip route planning
- use of a second driver to avoid any stops

Overall common concern: No sufficient parking areas let alone safe and secure **TPAs** Information on SSTPAs not available or not accurate • A minority of existing SSTPAs provide online booking Urgent need for booking systems Site surveillance & control Lighting Fencing Emergency contact points Specific request from insurers and shippers Urgent need for commonly agreed definition and standards
